Episode 6: *Person Not Platform: In Spirit and in Truth* Date: January 25 2021

In this episode I reference some thoughts from Rabbi Aharon Mendez on the fall of Lucifer as seen from one lens.

Psalm 29:25 Tree of Life Version reads Fear of man will prove to be a snare, but one who trusts in Adonai will be kept safe.

3 But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so your minds may be corrupted from the [a]simplicity that is in Christ. 2 Corinthians 11:3 New King James Version

12 “How you are fallen from heaven, O [a]Lucifer, son of the morning! How you are cut down to the ground, You who weakened the nations! 13 For you have said in your heart: ‘I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation On the farthest sides of the north; 14 I will ascend above the heights of the clouds, I will be like the Most High.’ 15 Yet you shall be brought down to Sheol, To the [b]lowest depths of the Pit.

Isaiah 14:12-16 New King James Version

Jesus said, “I know. I saw Satan fall, a bolt of lightning out of the sky. ... No one can put a hand on you. All the same, the great triumph is not in your authority over evil, but in God’s authority over you and presence with you. Not what you do for God but what God does for you—that’s the agenda for rejoicing.”
